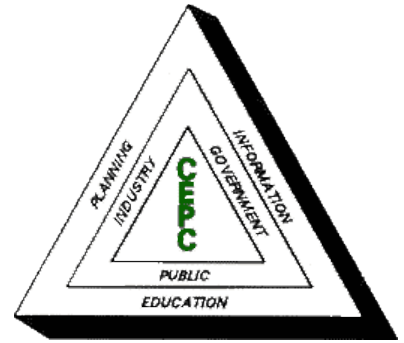

Here are some pieces of information that will help give some context and spur thought for our March discussion on meeting content and format. We ask that you digest this information and then come to the meeting in March ready to reformat the business of the committee:

- 1) The current standing report outs for CERT, Neighborhood Watch, and MRC are based on a decades old information that the CEPC provides direction and oversight to CERT, Neighborhood Watch, and MRC. That basis no longer exists as each agency that the programs fall under provide direction and oversight.
- 2) The CEPC spotlight section was meant for getting to know other reps and facilities/agencies. It has been challenging to get routine volunteers to do a 5-10 minute presentation.
- 3) Based on current feedback and discussions, there isn't as much networking or relationship building in the CEPC as people would like.
- 4) CEPC attendees don't understand their role or how elements of the current meeting format applies to them.
- 5) Over the years, we have included additional sectors and industries making the committee more all hazard with the understanding that there will be emphasis on hazardous material.

Some questions for consideration for reinventing the meetings:

- 1) What should everyone be bringing to the table?
- 2) What do you want to get out of the CEPC meetings? What information is relevant?
- 3) How can the CEPC work for you
- 4) What opportunities exist within the CEPC and how do we capitalize on them?
